THIS HUMBLE EFFORT to assemble the record of the LAMPERT family has been prompted primarily by the fact that my niece and nephew have had very little direct contact with their father's family since his death when they were young. It is an attempt to make up to them in part for this loss.

Perhaps the fact that so many Lampert's have married Lampert's has made us Lampert conscious. The records from Flasch will show that it was not uncommon for those of like names to inter-marry there. Many of the women have given their maiden name to one of their children as a Christian name.

We have not been a famous family: we have lived and died as plain, honest citizens. A few of us have been active in local, state and national life; a few in religious spheres; all of us have contributed to the physical, mental and spiritual needs of those about us. Our occupations have been diverse, with perhaps more teachers, merchants and farmers than in other professions. There has been a bond of unity among us that has expressed itself especially in giving a "home" to children left homeless through the death of a parent.

Almost all to whom application has been made have been prompt and helpful, and to each I would express my sincere appreciation. But especial thanks are due to my aged Aunt Anna Widmann whose memory and interest assisted me in reaching families of whom most of us had never heard; to Catherine Von Moos who consulted tomb-stones and church records to add to facts that could otherwise not have been obtained; to Martin Lampert whose sudden call from this life last Christmas left his eagerness to see the completed record unsatisfied; to my Cousin Louisa Lampert Yung whose Chart gave me impetus in beginning the gathering of this record; to H. Kunz, president of Flasch, whose generous, prompt and efficient help has added many facts of special interest to us in America; to my niece, Lucille Lampert Hellmers, who spent many hours of her travel time last August copying all the Lampert names from the Flasch records; and to my cousin Lou Walker Garlow who translated the scholarly German of the research work done in gathering this material.

Much more time could be spent in gathering together "the fragments," especially in the American part of the records. The work has been done entirely by mail. It has been especially difficult to get data from state, city and church records in America; most of the answers have been, "No Record." I apologize for the gaps. Perhaps some other member of the family will at a future time have the interest and take the time to do better. It is hoped that this work may prove of value in such an effort.

OF INTEREST

GRAUBUNDEN

Graubunden, or The Grisons, is the largest canton in Switzerland. It owes its name to the alliance of the three Leagues which in turn derive their title from the *Ligia Grigia* (that is, Gray League) of the Vorder-Rheinthal, the first to assert its democratic independence of authority. The historical career of the three Leagues really opened in 1471, and the state thus formed was called Graubunden, or in Romance *I Signori Grigioni*, whence the modern name, "The Grisons."

In Roman times Graubunden was the province of Rhaetia, and for centuries this canton preserved traces of Roman civilization. In the ninth century it was cut off from Italy and made part of Germany. . . . The Reformation provoked Austria to renew her old attempts to subjugate the Grisons. . . . The Leaguers rose in rebellion at Austrian control; this was crushed with ruthless brutality, and it was definitely annexed to Austria. . . . On May 25, 1637, the Leaguers concluded a treaty with Austria, whereby the League was guaranteed freedom of religion within the League-land. . . . Napoleon tried to incorporate the Graubunden in the Helvetic Republic. The Graubunders suspected Napoleon, and mistrusted their own power of maintaining their independence in a artificial state created by him out of the ruins of the ancient Swiss Confederation. A theatre of war resulted between the three great powers: France, Russia and Austria. Out of utter weariness, the inhabitants acquiesced quietly in the Act of Mediation of 1813, since when Graubunden has been a canton of the Swiss Confederation.

FLASCH

Canton of Grisons, district of Landquart, township of Maienfeld; 1722 ft. above sea level. Incorporated village at the foot of the Flascherberg, not far from the right shore of the Rhine; about 5 miles from the railroad station of Maienfeld, on the Sargans-Coire Division. Post office and telephone station. The incorporated village, together with a section of Luziensteig, numbers 81 homes: 333 inhabitants of the Protestant faith and 21 of the Catholic faith. Major occupation, cattle-breeding. There are good vineyards. Not far from the village are the remains of the ancient spas of Flasch; there is also, in the vicinity of the village, a cavern of stalactites called the Flascherloch. In 1525, a preacher from Zurich (possibly Burkli or Bolt) preached the Reform at Flasch. The village was destroyed by fire in 1622, and again in 1822. At the Luziensteig there was found a stone ax and bronze hair ornaments (dating back to the Bronze Era). Flasch is the home of a well known family by the name of Anhorn, a member of which, Bartholome Anhorn (deceased in 1640) left a valuable chronical of the Thirty Years War. In 891, the village name was Fassia.

THE NAME LAMPERT

The name of LAMPERT (in former times identical with Lambert, Lambrecht) originated from the first name Lambrecht (in Latin *Lambertus*) at the time when people had only one name and the habit of bearing family names was developed. It originated from the old-German word "Land", and originally was spelled: Landoberht, Landbert, Lampert, Lampart, etc.

The name LAMPERT, especially the earlier writing LAMPART, undoubtedly shows upper Italian origin. By the name LAMPARTS (today Lombardy) one understood in the Middle Ages people from the duchy of Mailand. One who migrated at that time into the neighboring German province would then have been called LAMPART on account of coming from there.

For the origin of the name, the old form LAMPART points to the Italian tribe of Lombards, here called Lamparts.

COAT-OF-ARMS

There are two noble Austrian families, the Counts and the nobleman LAMPERT. These families are not in existence any more.

An Imperial Patent granted a coat-of-arms to three brothers LAMPERT in 1593, and a Patent of nobility for two of these brothers in 1603. There are also a number of patents to be found for bearers of the name Lamberti, and of Lambrecht.

In the collections of this locality (Chur) appear no coat-of-arms of the Lampert family.

Probably there is an inter-relation between the Austrian LAMPERT'S and those in Flasch, since Flasch adjoins the Austrian boundaries and for that reason emigrations and marriages could be assumed between the neighboring communities. From there also the Lampert's emigrated widely in all directions.

NEWS ITEMS

The oldest date for the LAMPERT family goes back to 1379. Under this date, a LAMPERT from Flasch took up citizenship in the town of Chur (also spelled Coire: hauptstadt or capital of Graubunden). But this branch of LAMPERT'S must have died out in Chur, for some time later there was no more trace of a Lampert in Chur. Only in 1854 did a branch of the same name again purchase citizenship there.

1475-1504 Clauss Lampert) established an anniversary for the church at

1544, Mar. 3 - Franz Lampert and his wife Elsy, born Senti, with other citizens of Jenins bought property, from the community of Jenins, which had belonged to the Castle Aspermont. (Mohr's Documents)

1547, Nov. 11 - Valentin Lampartt and two other village-jurors of the community of Flasch sold the Bath of Flasch to Joos Hartner and his wife Anna, born Stadler, citizens of Maiefeld. Valentin and Peter Lampartt are neighbors. (Mohr's Documents).

1548, Feb. 2 - The village-jurors of Flasch: Valentin Lampartt, Lux Adank and Peter Hermann bought a year's rent (or taxes) for the com-

munity of Flasch from a family of Maienfeld. (Archives of Maienfeld, No. 207).

1552, Sept. 18 - Valentin Lampartt, Lux Adank and Uli Anhorn as village-jurors of Flasch made, with the town council of Maienfeld, 5 magistrates from Malans and 3 from Jenins, - certain decisions relative to Alpine pastures and the use of these. (Archives of Maienfeld & Mohr's Documents).

1596, Petter Lampert in Davos is the owner of the property "in den Larchen". (Archives of Davos).

? Mrs. Margareth Lampert in Davos-Spina bequeathed the school of Davos a sum of money. (Archives of Davos).

1776 Martin Lampert of Flasch made an agreement with the community relative to the arsenal. (Archives of Flasch).

Genealogical Addenda:

These cannot be more perfectly ascertained, since in the year 1822 a large part of the village of Flasch, including the parsonage and church books, was burned. (The fire lasted seven days.) Afterwards with a great deal of effort the records of the families were fixed up as well as possible, - but only so that the oldest dates went back to about 1750. These can only be discovered from the dates of death and declarations of ages, and this would require research that would take a lot of time. Relationships can be proved only from 1750 on, older ones only casually. For that reason, the relationship of Jakob, Florian and Christian cannot be further determined, except perhaps accidentally from tax lists or something of the sort.

Outside of the branches (Jakob, Florian and Christian, pp. 5, 34, 25, resp. included on the enclosed sheets, there lived besides in Flasch about 15 Lampert families between 1760 and 1800, whose connections remain unknown. Even so further research about members of the families since 1830 would result in quite a bit of supplementary material.

A son of the above couple, Johann Peter born May 7, 1805 died in Naples, as also did Lukas in 1851, son of Zacharias. Whether these were there in military service or in other business is unknown. At that time confederates were often in service at Naples, very seldom were Protestants in the service of the Vatican.

In the year 1822 almost the entire village of Flasch was burned. The fire is said to have been started by a band of thieves. - H. Kunz, Flasch.

Dates of arrival in America could not be obtained: the Customs House in New York City was burned about 1860; and the data in New Orleans is just now being indexed. - This would be available in another year.

Other Lampert's have been noted listed in New York City and Philadelphia: it was learned that these came from England, Holland, Germany and Russia. No doubt there are also some who have come from France, for a Chicago Newspaper some twenty-five years ago traced a family of Lampert's to that country.

In the additional data gathered by my niece in Flasch, is the complete record of the five sons: Christian, Mathias, Martin, Johann Ulrich and Bernard, of Mathias Lampert and Dorothea Gadiens. There are also two other families of Christian Lampert; and another Mathias Lampert, son of Jacob and Maria Lampert, who married an Anna Held—no children. It is probable, because of similarity of names, that there is a relationship to our family, but since this cannot be established,—due to the Fire of 1822,—and it would be a remote relationship at best, these families are not included in this volume.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Section I. consists of the direct line of the Lampert Family to which the author belongs.

Section II. consists of the ALLIED Family of the 1st child in the 3rd generation in Section I.

Section III. consists of the Allied Family of the 3rd child of the 3rd generation in Section I.

Section IV. consists of the Allied Family of the 4th child of the 3rd generation in Section I.

It was not possible to obtain data for the Allied Family of the 2nd child in the 3rd generation of Section I.

Each section begins with the oldest data obtained brought down to the 4th generation, with a † before the names carried on down to the present in succeeding pages. These are carried on in the order in which they appear in the first paragraph of the Section.

All data from Flasch was obtained from the Town Records at that place; data of families in America was obtained chiefly from members of the various families.

Information from Flasch is incomplete when marriage was to a person living elsewhere in Europe.

When two or more events take place in the same city, the name of the state is generally not repeated within the record of the family.

When two or more children are born in the same place, the location is generally given before the names of the children are listed.

The following cities whose names appear in the parts of the record obtained from Flasch and Malans are in Switzerland: Altstadten, Azmoos, Chur, Cumbels, Davos, Der Guscha, Disentis, Flasch, Heiden, Igis, Ins, Jenins, Landquart, Maienfeld, Maladers, Malans, Mels, Ober-Aegeri, Sils und Safien, Thurgau, Untervas, Valzeina, Wald, Wergenstein, most of them in Graubunden.

Abbreviations used are b. for born, d. for died, m. for married, and unm. for unmarried.

The order followed in listing data for individuals is: birth date and place, (if dead) death date and place, marriage date and place, name of spouse with birth date and place, death date and place, items of interest for first person of paragraph, then like items for spouse, present address. (It is regretted that no items of interest appear for many of the persons: it was not possible to gather them without taking much more time).

The Roman numeral gives the position of the person within the immediate family; the number in parentheses () immediately following each name indicates the generation (of this record) to which the person belongs.

The Blank Pages at the end of the Index are for corrections, additions, etc.
